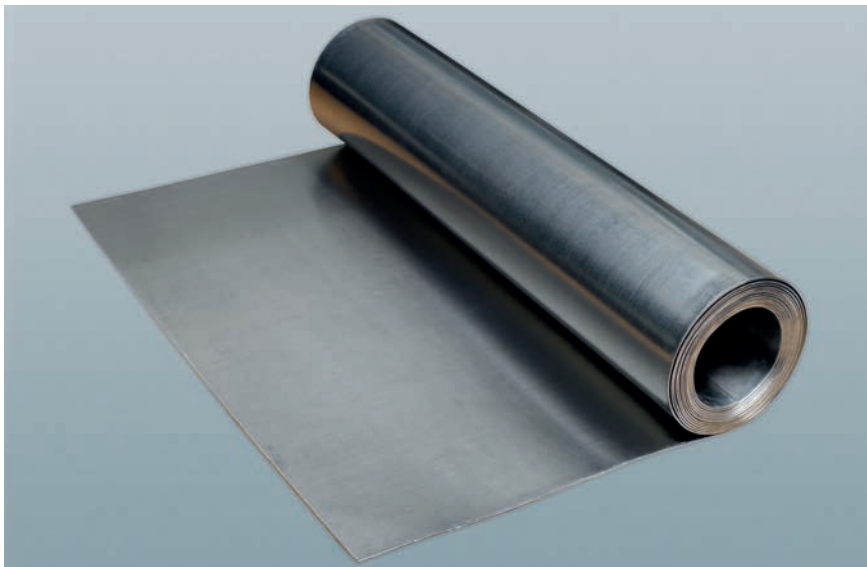

For listed and modern buildings

When left untreated, Lead sheet to DIN EN 12588 develops a characteristic patina under the influence of the weather. This effect is often desirable, as it acquires the authentic look of countless historic buildings - but it can lend modern buildings a striking visual appearance too. If the sheets are treated with patination oil from Röhr + Stolberg following fitting, however, their original metallic appearance is retained.

Easy to lay

Lead sheet to DIN EN 12588 is suitable for sealing and can also be laid on large surfaces. Lead sheet to DIN EN 12588 is handled and worked following the technical regulations of the Gütegemeinschaft Saturnblei e.V.
